GD 121 Image Manipulation Final Assignment

For your final assignment you will have a choice of creating:

- 1. A composite/retouch image
- 2. A digital illustration

Composite/Retouch image

You will create a seamless composite of at least four images, including whichever image you use as your background image. Your source material should be taken from gettyimages.com or other high quality stock image repository. You will be penalized for using inferior/low quality/low resolution source imagery. Your composite image must have:

- At least three sources other than the background (minimum four images total)
- Consistent lighting for all included elements in the scene
- High quality imagery as source material
- The source material should be turned in along with your layered complete image

Minimum size for your completed composition: 3000x2600

Digital Illustration

You will create an original illustration using Photoshop as your main tool of creation. You may start from original sketches or drawings or work solely in digital form. Your digital Illustration must have:

- Basis in some original artwork that you personally have created
- Multiple layers
- A strong composition that includes foreground and background elements (no floating characters)
- The source material (sketches, paintings, etc.) should be turned in along with your layered complete image

Minimum size for your completed composition: 3000x2600

Your completed final project should be in a folder named **GD121lastnameFinal**. For example a student named John Smith would turn in a folder named **GD121smithFinal**. Inside that folder should be all the expected files mentioned above. Your complete file should still have the layers intact and the layers should be well named and organized.
